In January 2014, he led the team of the gastroenterology department which reconstructed the esophagus of a patient without opening her thorax or her abdomen, completely endoscopically. This less invasive surgical technique reduces trauma and postoperative complications. This had been a world premiere, carried out in Marseille in January 2014.
